

Screening Services Group – Covid protocols – 16 Nov 21

All are rooms are Open.

Per LA County Health Department - We are required to post a sign stating that masks are required and that masks are available. We are not required to enforce mask wearing.

At Sepulveda and the Sepulveda Screening Room Art Gallery, only those fully vaccinated, plus two weeks may enter either room.

We do not require everyone to be fully vaccinated at our other locations, but we highly recommend that only those fully vaccinated, plus two weeks be allowed to attend.

We sanitize after every screening.

HVAC systems:

- Wilshire uses Merv 10 and has a higher change over of air. The air goes to the roof and returns. There is a separate Merv 13 filter in the screening room.
- Rodeo uses Merv 10 filters. The air goes to the roof and returns. There is a separate Merv 13 filter in the screening room.
- Sepulveda uses Merv 13, has a higher air change over and has independent HVAC and does not share air with the rest of the building.
- Fine Arts uses Merv 13, has a higher air change over and has independent HVAC and is a single screen building and does not share air with anyone else.

We are full capacity:

- Fine Arts - 410
- Sepulveda - 71
- Wilshire – 50
- Rodeo – 49
- QC Room – 17

The maximum capacity does not include reps, or security. (Except Rodeo, 49 max per fire code.)
